May 16, 2023 Special District Election



When is the Next Election?

The next countywide election will be the **May 16, 2023 Special District Election**. It will include contests for school, fire, water, and other special districts. It will also include local levy and bond measures. **March 16 at 5 p.m.** is the deadline for candidates to file for office and jurisdictions to file measure for inclusion on the ballot. **The Voter Registration Deadline is April 25.**

What is on the Ballot?

On the ballot there will be contests for the following:

Positions

- Local School Boards
- Water Districts
- Transportation Districts
- Community College Boards
- Park and Rec. Districts
- Fire Districts
- Education Service Districts
- Other Special Districts

City and District Levy and Bond Measures

- City of West Linn(Mayor)
- Molalla Rural Fire
- Lake Grove Fire District
- Canby Fire
- Monitor Rural Fire
- Lake Oswego School District
- Colton School District
- Clackamas County Fire

All registered voters of Clackamas County will receive a ballot for the election. Where you live determines what measures, and contests are on your ballot.

How to Register or Update Registration

There are three ways that a person can register to be able to vote:



Online

You can register online at the Oregon Secretary of State Website, by going to www.originates.gov. Note: For this process you will need an Oregon Driver Licences or DMV Number.



Registration Card

You can register by using a registration form. This form can be acquired from most post offices and libraries, or the Elections Office. Or they can be found online and printed at the Oregon SOS Website.



Motor Voter

When gaining your license or updating your information with the DMV, you may also choose to register to vote. This will then register you to vote, or update your voter registration.

The last day for new voters to register is April 25th, however already registered voters can update their information at any time.
