May 2023 Election

When is the next Election?

The next countywide election is occurring **May 16th, 2023**. This election will focus on the various special districts within the County.

What is on the Ballot?

On the ballot there will be contests for the following:

Positions

- Local School Boards
- Community College Boards
- Education Service Districts
- Transportation Districts
- Fire Districts
- Water Districts
- Park and Rec. Districts

City and District Measure and Contests

- City of Oregon City: Borrowing for Oregon City Urban Renewal Agency.
- City of West Linn: Special election to fill the vacancy for Mayor
- Molalla Rural Fire Protection: Measure 3-591 - Local Option Renewal Levy to Maintain Fire, Emergency Medical Operations

All registered voters of Clackamas County will receive a ballot for the election. Where you live determines what measures, and contests are on your ballot.

How do I vote?

Reviving my Ballot

All voters will receive their ballots by mail. However, if needed Ballots can be acquired in-person by request at the Clackamas County Elections Office. Ballots will be **sent out/ available on April 26th, 2023**.

Voting my Ballot

On the ballot, you will fill in the bubble located next to the candidates name you wish to vote for. You are **not required to vote for every position**, and your ballot will be counted for everything you did vote for. **Do not vote multiple times** on one position unless specified.

Casting my Ballot

Voters can return their ballots three ways:

- Returning it **via mail**.
- Dropping off the ballot at a locked **Drop Box**.
- By returning it to the **Elections Office**.

Voters can return their ballots at anytime via any of these methods, before **May 16th at 8:00pm**.
